

## **NOTICE OF APPEAL**

The registrant has 15 days to file a notice of appeal after the earlier of (1) PIR notifying the registrant that it will not lift the suspension or (2) within 7 days of PIR's receipt of the initial notice provided by the registrant.

### **SUBMISSION OF INITIAL DISPUTE TO REGISTRY**

Within 60 days of suspension, a registrant wishing to appeal must first contact PIR with an initial request to lift the domain suspension.

# **RESPONSE**

BY PIR

Within 15 days after the commencement date PIR will submit its response.

# **FILING FEE**

within 10 days of filing the notice commencement date

#### TIME FOR **DECISION**

The panelist has 10 days from the receipt of the party's submissions to make a decision, but that time maybe extended by the panelist.

**APPOINTMENT**

Within 10 days of the commencement date,

### DISQUALIFICATION **OF PANELIST**

Within 7 days, a party may request to disqualify a panelist..

### **ENFORCEMENT OF DECISION**

If registrant prevails, PIR shall 7 days; and (2) reimburse the registrant the filing fee incurred to bring the appeal within 30 days.

# **PAYMENT OF**

Registrant must pay the filing fee of appeal or the matter will be dismissed. Within 5 days of payment, FORUM will send the notice of appeal to PIR. which is called the
